In 1731 the Meissen manufactory began a new genre in European porcelain, producing several hundred life-size and near-life-size porcelain birds and animals. Porcelain birds have their origins in the tradition of maintaining collections of living animals and birds in menageries and aviaries, which were viewed as emblems of royal power and enlightenment.
